

**PRIMADONNA ELENA MOSUC BEST SOPRANO  
2019 INTERNATIONAL OPERA AWARD- OSCAR  
DELLA LIRICA**



Opera Star Elena Mosuc has received on October 1 at Teatro Malibran in Venice the International Opera Award 2019 – Oscar della Lirica as Best soprano of the year. During the evening that saw the participation of tenor Francesco Demuro (Best Tenor 2019), Anna Maria Chiuri (Best Mezzosoprano 2019) and Riccardo Zanellato (Best Basso 2019), Mosuc sang three highlights of her repertoire: “Oh madre dal cielo”, the great Primadonna scene of Giselda in Act II of Verdi’s Lombardi, a character that the famous soprano has triumphally debuted on September 26 at Kolozsvári Magyar Opera in Cluj-Napoca (Romania); the duet from Lucia di Lammermoor (“Verranno a te sull’aure) with Francesco Demuro and “Follie! Follie! Sempre libera” from La Traviata, dedicated to legendary singer Maria Malibran. Opera critics of magazine DeArtes ([http:// www.deartes.cloud/?p=12083](http://www.deartes.cloud/?p=12083)) wrote about Mosuc performance: “She generously donated her art to the audience, excelling in her elegant highest registers, Elena Mosuc, an authentic soprano drammatico d’agilità and high-class Belcanto singer, as he said the host of the evening, Enrico Stinchelli. [...] The Romanian-Swiss star has thrilled the audience with extremely difficult arias, which she brilliantly solved with her technical knowledge and interpretative sensitivity and by the extraordinary freshness of her voice, starting from „Oh madre dal cielo” from I Lombardi and later with „Verranno a te sull’aure” by Lucia di Lammermoor, performed with all the notes written by Donizetti, remarked Stinchelli”. Mosuc will celebrate next year her 30th anniversary of International career and as she stated this prize it had to be considered as one of culminating moments of her career. She recently received also two nominations for Opus Classic 2019 as Best Singer of the year and Best Album for her CD “Verdi Heroines” (Solo Musica/Sony).
